God bless you, and have a great summer!

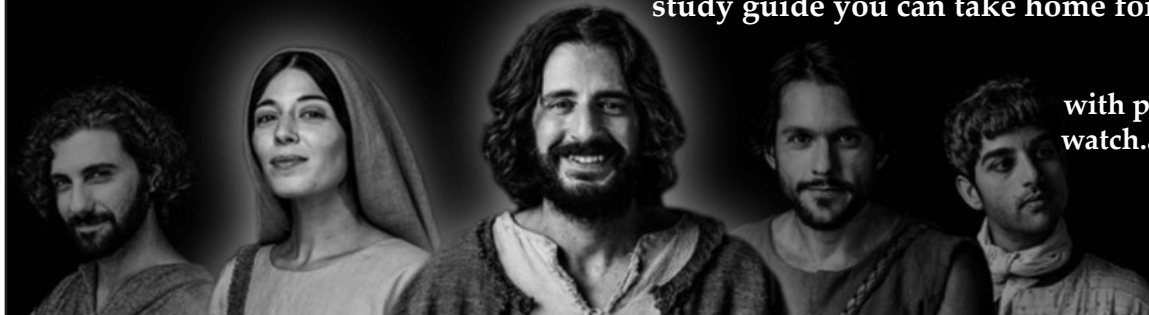
