# FBC KIDS

#### Following God's Lead: Lessons from Moses and the Israelites

This past month in FBC Kids, we journeyed through the life of Moses and the Israelites. Each week, we opened our Bibles and discovered how God was present, powerful, and personal as He led His people from slavery to freedom.

The series Lead the Way started with God calling Moses from a burning bush (Exodus 2–3), teaching us that **God shows us how to lead**. That Sunday, a child asked, "Why would God pick someone who was hesitant



to lead?" We talked about how Moses provided many excuses, but God chose him and performed many miracles. That earnest question sparked a wonderful discussion about having courage when God asks us to do something, being obedient, and how God can use us as a part of His plan.

Next, we learned how God protected His people through the Ten Plagues and the first Passover (Exodus 7–12), reminding us that **we can follow God's lead, even when it is hard**. One child said, "It's kind of like how we follow instructions when we don't always understand them, but we still trust." What a powerful insight from such a young heart! We also discussed Pharaoh's hard heart and how his actions affected all of the Egyptians.

Then, we saw how God led the Israelites out of Egypt and parted the Red Sea (Exodus 13–15), showing us that **God leads us to safety**. We talked about how, in one direction, the Israelites saw the Red Sea, and in the other, they saw the Egyptians, and God made a way through the sea. We talked about how God may not always make a problem disappear; instead, He leads us through it. Finally, we explored how God provided food and water in the wilderness (Exodus 15–16). The kids were amazed that bread came down from the sky! Through this, we learned that **God gives us what we need**.

One of the many things I love about children's ministry is that some of the wild Old Testament stories become deeply personal and meaningful in the hearts of our kids. They ask big questions, connect the dots, see God's faithfulness, and begin to trust Him for themselves.

Please continue to pray for the children of FBC—that they will see God's hand in their own lives, just like the Israelites did. Pray for our amazing leaders, who joyfully guide and love these kids every week.

It is a blessing to walk alongside this generation as they learn to trust God, follow His lead, and discover that He is with them every step of the way.


